**Treasurer's Report** by Kim Weinreich. The checkbook summary of deposits and withdrawals was presented. Motion by Ron Popp to approve report, seconded by Steve Weinreich.

Correspondence: AWSC Annual Fall workshop was held Oct 31- Nov 2, 2014 in Wisconsin Dells, 2 members attended and brought back information on the WI Trail Pass going into effect in July 2015. Gary Wagner and Kim Weinreich reported on the changes coming. The WI trail Pass is new in 2015 and is separate from your snowmobile registration. Your snowmobile club will be responsible for your AWSC membership when you pay your snowmobile club membership dues which will make you eligible for the discounted Trail Pass. When eligible each member can purchase their own Trail Pass/Passes. The pass will be a sticker that is displayed on your snowmobile. Each member can purchase the trail pass online through the AWSC website, call AWSC office, walk in AWSC office or mail check or CC info to AWSC. Antique Sled changes- Act 233 allows sleds 35 years and older to be registered as antiques. Registration stickers will say Antique. Cost \$20.00 for 2 years and renewed for \$5.00 for 2 years. Changes before next winter will be made in the 2015-2016 state budget. Original antique registration will cost \$20.00 for 3 years and renewals \$5.00 for 3 years. Trail Pass will be included in antique registration, (will not need a trail pass sticker). RA snowmobile club is preparing for the changes through website upgrades and looking into taking memberships and payment through the website. This action will allow for speedier AWSC access to current club membership which will ensure speedy transmittal to AWSC so that a member can promptly order the sticker that they need to display on the windshield.

**Trail and Equipment Report**: Ultimate and tractor maintenance done. Brighter lights installed on the Ultimate. Brushing of the snowmobile trails is complete. Thank you to all the volunteers that helped. Purchased a 4x8 foot aluminum trailer for \$450.00.

All equipment is inspected and ready to go for this season. Finance committee in future to discuss aging groomer and cost to replace it. A special Thank You to **Lee Eppinger** for donating an impact wrench and socket set that was much needed!
